The 2007 annual North Carolina German Immersion Weekend for advanced German students will be held on November 9-10 that Camp Caraway in Asheboro. The camp is sponsored by the North Carolina chapter of the American Association of Teachers of German (AATG). It is a great tradition going back to 1980.

The theme for this year's camp will be **Musik: Die Sprache der Welt**. Among the events planned are:
