"Alp Dreams: Forest Trails and Mountain Tales"


Presenter: David Limburg, Guilford College

Presenters: Christina Humphrey, Providence High School and Ingrid Bialas-Wilson, South Mecklenburg High School

- Introduction: Enliven student writing skills in the direction of the AP German Exam to develop:
 - · ...contrast & comparison skills
 - · ...the ability of students to express their opinions
 - ...the students' ability to answer questions and support their answers
 - ...the students' ability to filter out facts and data from various sources
 - ...the students' ability to form hypotheses from information presented to them

"Speaking Assessments for Proficiency"

Presenter: Wendy Burgbacher, Cary Academy High School

- Introduction: Using competency-based learning to assess students for speaking proficiency; some methods/tasks are:
 - Socratic seminar
 - Talk Show
 - Dinner with the host family
 - AP-style recorded assessments

- Using class mascots (plush toys) to describe situations and travel: Students bring the "animals" home on the weekend and take photos of them to later describe in class in the target language.
 To prevent the presenter from memorizing their presentation, student audience members in the classroom must pose questions about the "animals" weekend.
- A general explanation of how to align competency/standards-based learning to a traditional letter grade scale was provided. A grammar component was also integrated for verb tense/mood. Other grammar components aren't considered unless they impede comprehensibility.
- A brainstorming session followed, where attendees discussed various oral proficiency tasks and their advantages.

Presenters: Linda Horvath, Charlotte Catholic High School and Sabine Schmid-Rankin, Forestview High School

- Introduction: An in-depth student teaching unit based upon the graphic short novel "Die Lisa" by Klaus Kordon
- Lisa's life spans the entirety of the 20th century, giving students a rich target-language based historical backdrop to engage in several classroom activities:
 - Invent a person in the 20th century
 - Make a timeline
 - Write a diary
 - Create a dialog between central characters in the story
 - Have one character in the story write a letter to the other
